We are excited to start Kids Club this fall!

Thank you for having your child(ren) participate in Kids Club each week! We count it as a privilege to come along side you in the discipleship of your child. As we start the year, we want to remind you of our procedures and policies that enable all children to have a great experience at Kids Club.

We offer Kids Club for children entering 3K-5th grade in the Fall of 2022. The 3 years must have turned 3 before September 1st, 2022 and be able to use the restroom on their own and have basic listening skills.

We meet each Wednesday evening from 5:30 - 6:30. **Please drop off and pick up your children at the WEST doors.**

When the children arrive, they will check in at the table and be directed to go straight into their breakout room.

At the end of the night we will be together as a large group in the Middle School Room (Room 105) before dismissing. **Please enter the church to get your child(ren) as we do not let them out the doors unattended.**

In order to make Kids Club a valuable experience for your kids, we have a few details that we need you to be aware of:

1. Your kids will come home excited about what they have learned and experienced at Kids Club. Please encourage your child and take an enthusiastic interest as they tell you about their night or recite the verses they learned. While it is not required that you work with you children throughout the week to memorize scripture, they will be so much more successful if you commit to making it a part of your daily routine.
2. Each child will receive a book that will have their memory work and a short lesson. Please make sure they remember to bring the book each week.
3. The books that we will be using are part of the AWANA curriculum. If you are not familiar with AWANA, they traditionally have incorporated the use of uniforms and badges, much like the Scouts have used. We will **not** be using the uniforms or badges. However, your children will still earn points with their participation, and those points will be able to be redeemed for prizes at our Kids Club STORE.

Be sure to to grab a calendar from the check-in table or check Harvest's Facebook page to keep up-to-date with the weekly themes and Club dates.

We follow the Beaver Dam School District for winter weather cancelations. If they cancel school, we will cancel clubs for that night. At times we have bad storms that arrive after the school day and we have to cancel Clubs. Please download our Harvest App (Search Harvest Beaver Dam on your favorite app store) and allow notifications to receive these weather updates or check our Harvest Facebook page for up to the minute details.
