

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS
Week 4
Exodus 16-34; Psalm 22-28

1. In what ways do we see God providing for the Israelites in these chapters?
2. What was God's stipulation about gathering the "manna?" Why was this important?
3. During the battle against Amalek, ". . .when Moses held his hand up, Israel prevailed; but when he let his hand down, Amalek prevailed..." What symbolism might God have intended to convey through this scene?
4. Why did God ask Moses to set up a perimeter or fence around the mountain?
(Chapter 19)
5. For what purpose does God ask Moses to have the Israelites construct a sanctuary?
(Chapter 25)
6. Where was the Tabernacle to be located?
7. God's "blueprint" for the Tabernacle is quite detailed! Notice He didn't say, "Construct the Tabernacle according to whatever design you think best." What does the detailed nature of God's design tell us about the requirements of being in His presence?
8. What aspect of the Tabernacle do you find most fascinating? Why?
9. Share which Psalm from our weekly reading encouraged or challenged you most.
