

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS
Week 5
Exodus 35 - Leviticus 18; Psalm 29-35

1. In what ways do we see God provide the materials and skills needed for the Tabernacle? (Exodus 35-39)
2. The Hebrew word for “atonement” occurs in various forms at least 59 times in the Book of Leviticus—far more frequently than any other book in the Bible. Based on the context of some of these occurrences, how would you define “atonement” in your own words?
3. Why did the alter and priestly garments need to be sprinkled with the blood of a sacrifice?
4. How do you see Jesus’ sinless life and substitutionary death on the cross symbolized in the rituals of sacrificial atonement?
5. What was the sin of Nadab and Abihu? Why was their offering unacceptable? (Leviticus 10:1-3)
6. How is leprosy like sin? What imagery of the Gospel is found in the ceremony for cleansing a leper? (Leviticus 14:1-9)
7. Describe the ceremony for the Day of Atonement. (Leviticus 16)
8. What does it mean to “wait” for the Lord? (Psalms 31:24; 33:18)
