### **Week 7**

#### **Numbers 11 - 30 ; Psalm 43-49**

- 1. How is the Bible reading going? Share tips and tricks you've discovered to keep yourself and your family engaged and up to speed!**
- 2. Pastor Chris didn't like the word "fickle" but couldn't find a better word to describe the Israelites attitude toward God. What are some other words or phrases that describe the up and down nature of their faith?**
- 3. In Numbers 11:1-9, the people are described as being "like those who complain of adversity" (11:1) and their cravings are described as "greedy" (11:4). What does this teach us about God's expectations of His people? How might this apply to our modern lives?**
- 4. What did the spies see in the land that caused 10 of them to lose faith? (Numbers 13:25-33)**
- 5. What was unique about the Israelites' sin in Chapter 14 such that the consequence was complete and final?**
- 6. What were the "tassels" meant to be a reminder of? (Numbers 15:37-41) How might we have similar reminders in our life today?**
- 7. Which Psalm from this week's reading did you find most challenging, encouraging or relatable? Why?**
