

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Week 10

Deuteronomy 32 - Judges 3 ; Psalm 64 - 70

Reminder: Be sensitive to group dynamics and to the leading of the Holy Spirit. Let these questions serve as “springboards” for deeper discussion and tangible application. Please don’t feel constrained to limit discussion to these specific questions.

- 1. What stands out to you about Moses’ command to the Israelites in Deuteronomy 32:46-47?**
- 2. Why was Moses not permitted to enter the Promised Land? (Deuteronomy 32:51)**
- 3. Read Joshua 1:1-9. In this section, what does God command? What does God promise?**
- 4. How does the Story of Rahab foreshadow the Gospel? (Joshua 2)**
- 5. Why did God stop providing Manna in Joshua 5:12?**
- 6. In Joshua 5:13, Joshua asks the angel, “Are you for us or for our enemies?” What can we learn from the angels response in Joshua 5:13?**
- 7. Israel was successful against the impenetrable city of Jericho, but in Joshua 7 they failed against the lesser opponent, Ai. What made the difference in these two battles?**
- 8. How are the Israelites tricked by the Gibeonites? (Joshua 9). What had the Israelites failed to do? (9:14)**
- 9. What stands out to you in Joshua’s farewell address? (Joshua 23)**
