Week 8

Numbers 31 - Deuteronomy 12 ; Psalm 50-56

- 1. In Numbers 35, God directs the Israelites to designate “Cities of Refuge.” What was the reason for and rules regarding these cities? In your opinion, is this a just solution? Why or why not?**
- 2. In Deuteronomy 1-3, Moses recounts the history of their travel from Egypt to the current day. What stood out to you about this summary? Why?**
- 3. What words or phrases did you notice repeated in Deuteronomy 1-12?**
- 4. Moses commands the Israelites to teach the children and grandchildren about God –His history with Israel, His promises and commandments, etc. Whose job was this?**
- 5. What methods of teaching are commanded in Deuteronomy 6:6-9?**
- 6. In Deuteronomy 6:20-25, Moses seems to suggest that for a child, the background and context for an answer about God’s commandments is as important as the answer itself. Why are the background and context important when explaining God’s commandments?**
- 7. Share some specific examples of God’s blessings for obedience that were given in these first twelve chapters of Deuteronomy.**
