Deuteronomy 13-31 ; Psalm 57-63

- 1. Deuteronomy 13 begins with a scenario in which God is testing the Israelites to find out what?**
- 2. How does God describe the Israelites in Deuteronomy 14:1-2. (3 Answers)**
- 3. In Deuteronomy 14:22-27, God directs the Israelites to tithe of “all the produce from which they sow” and to feast on this tithe “at the place where He chooses to establish His name” so *that* they may learn to “fear God” always. What is the meaning of “fear God” in this context?**
- 4. In Deuteronomy 17:18-20, God says that when the Israelites choose a king from among themselves, the king is to write out a copy of the law and read it every day of his life. What four reasons does God give for this command?**
- 5. In Deuteronomy 26:15, after an Israelite has completed all the various tithes required by the law, what does God then command that person to pray?**
- 6. In Deuteronomy 30:1-5, God says that at a future date, after the people have experienced both all the blessings and all the curses He has placed before them, a time of blessing will be experienced again. What change in the Israelites would bring about this blessing?**
- 7. Several of the Psalms we read this week represent a person crying out to God for help. What keeps you from asking God for help more often?**
