1 Kings 17 - 2 Kings 17; Psalm 99 - 105

- 1. God used an unclean bird and a foreign woman to provide for Elijah's physical needs during the famine. Share a time when God provided for you in an unexpected way.**
- 2. How did Elijah have the faith and courage needed to go before King Ahab even after hearing about the mass slaughter of the prophets? What step of courageous obedience is God asking you to take?**
- 3. How does the story of Mount Carmel showcase God's absolute power over darkness?**
- 4. Right after this experience, Elijah becomes afraid for his life and runs for cover. He even asks God to take his life. How does God ultimately appear to Elijah?**
- 5. Elijah and Elisha's lives are filled with stories of God's power. Which one speaks to you the most?**
- 6. What are some of the things listed in Psalm 100 that we can also thank God for?**
- 7. Psalm 105 recounts God's faithfulness to His people. Share an example of God's faithfulness to your family.**

Prayer Prompt: Spend some time this week praying for God's power to be displayed through your life. Pray for your faith to be strengthened through the Holy Spirit's presence so that you are equipped to bring Him glory through whatever you face in the coming year.
