Week 17

Isaiah 18 - 44 | Psalm 113 - 119:32

- 1. Chapters 13-23 of Isaiah pronounce judgement on various civilizations, culminating in the whole earth being judged in chapter 24. What reason for this judgement is given in Isaiah 24:5?**
- 2. What will be said by God's people on the day of judgement according to Isaiah 25:9? How can we be working while "waiting" to further God's kingdom?**
- 3. Read Isaiah 29:13-18. What does this passage caution us against and how can it convict us?**
- 4. In Isaiah 30:15, God says Israel will be delivered by "returning and resting" and her strength is described as a "quiet confidence." How do these statements differ from our typical notions of deliverance and strength?**
- 5. Read Isaiah 30:18-26. What are some of God's mercies to his people? How do they demonstrate how great His compassion is?**
- 6. We have probably all experienced times when we thought Isaiah 40:27b "My way is hidden from the Lord, and my claim is ignored by my God." What assurances are found in vs. 28-31 that make those thoughts/feelings untrue?**

Prayer Prompt: Read Psalm 119:9-16 as a prayer over your life. Pray for renewed strength to run and not grow weary (Isaiah 40:31). Pray for a heart that does not wander but delights in God's word.
