Week 22

Job 32 - Proverbs 6 | Psalm 143 - 149

1. Elihu confronts Job in Chapters 33-37. He accuses Job of being like the wicked in 34:7-8, 36-37. How does he describe Job's wickedness?
2. God asks Job a series of questions in Chapters 38-39. What is Job's response in 40:3-5?
3. In Job's second responses to God (40:3-5, 42:1-6) does he admit to having sinned and deserving punishment?
4. What happens to Job and his friends in 42:7-16?

Proverbs

5. What is the purpose of Proverbs in 1:1-7?
6. What is wisdom worth according to 2:4 and 3:14-15?
7. By what method do we find favor with God and people according to Proverbs 3:1-4?
8. Compare the "path of the righteous" to the "path of the wicked" from Proverbs 4:18-19. Does this always seem the case from our perspectives?

Prayer Prompt:

Read Proverbs 2 and pray for a heart that is *teachable*. Pray for a delight in knowledge and a desire to walk in the wisdom of the Lord while discerning when to reject the wisdom of the world.
