Proverbs 28 - Jeremiah 3 | Psalm 7 - 13

Proverbs

1. What characteristics of God are implied by Agur's questions in Proverbs 30:2-6? Why is it important that "every word of God is pure"?
2. What is the danger of having too much or too little according to Proverbs 30:8-9. How can we work towards contentment in our lives? What does "contentment" mean to you?

Ecclesiastes

3. After discussing the futility of all things, what is the conclusion of the matter in Ecc. 12:13-14. What do you think it means to "fear" God?

Song of Songs

4. Song of Songs gives us an idea of the passionate love Christ has for His Church. Do we as the modern church have this same desire to know Him intimately? Are there parts of our lives that we aren't willing to give over to Him?

Jeremiah

5. After the word of the Lord initially comes to Jeremiah telling him that he had been formed, set apart, and appointed to be God's prophet, Jeremiah immediately doubts his ability. God tells him not to be afraid of anyone "for I will be with you to rescue you." Was there a time in your life that you felt ill-equipped for the calling God had for you? How did God show up to rescue you?
6. In Jeremiah 3, God calls His children to return to Him. Have you felt that calling at a time in your life?
7. What is necessary for true repentance and how does God respond to it according to Jeremiah 3:12-13?

Read Psalm 8 and spend some time praising God for His magnificence, for the work of His fingers, and for His unfailing love for mankind.
