Week 25

Jeremiah 4 - 29 | Psalm 14 - 20

- 1. What was the cause of Jeremiah's lament in 4:19-26? As the world around us is still "skilled in doing what is evil, but they do not know how to do what is good," are we moved to cry out to God in anguish on behalf of the lost?**
- 2. What reasons are given for God sending disaster on the people in 6:16-21? Was there a time in your life that you "rejected" God's instructions? How was He faithful to bring you back to Himself?**
- 3. What does God want above sacrifice according to Jeremiah 7:21-26?**
- 4. Read Jeremiah 9:23-24. What do these verses caution us from taking pride in and what is our only valid reason for boasting?**
- 5. Read Chapter 10:1-16 and look for the contrasts between our One True God and the false gods of this world.**
- 6. How does God describe the person who trusts in man vs. the one who trusts in the Lord in 17:5-8? What are some ways you have been tempted to trust in your own strength? How has God blessed you for putting your confidence in Him?**
- 7. What picture does God give Jeremiah in Chapter 24? What will happen to the good and bad figs?**

Prayer Prompt:

Read Jeremiah 29:11-14. Pray for a heart that calls out to the Lord and searches after Him. Pray for confidence in the Lord's plans for your life, even if at the moment your situation might feel disastrous. Pray for eyes that see God's goodness and faithfulness to you.
