Week 26

Jeremiah 30 - 52 | Psalm 21 - 27

- 1. What are differences between the Old and New Covenants according to Jeremiah 31:31-34?**
- 2. What does Jeremiah 32:36-44 teach us about God's sovereignty and His love for His people?**
- 3. Read Jeremiah 32:39 and Proverbs 1.7. What "good" thing does the fear of the Lord begin in us? What benefit does this bring, to not just us, but to our descendants?**
- 4. According to Jeremiah 33:9, what will God provide His people that will cause other nations to tremble in awe? Knowing how tumultuous and violent the culture was at this time, what would this gift have meant for Israel?**
- 5. What stands out to you about Jeremiah's interaction with the captain of the guard in 40:2-5?**
- 6. The people go to Jeremiah for counsel in chapter 42 but immediately reject it. And then in chapter 43, they do exactly what God warns them not to do. In 43:8-13 what does God tell Jeremiah to build in the opening of Pharaoh's palace and what does it symbolize? God calls the King of Babylon His "servant" in verse 10. What does this teach us about God's ability to use even unbelievers to accomplish His purposes?**
- 7. Jeremiah ends with a demolished Jerusalem and 4,600 Israelites deported. While King Zedekiah ends up blind and imprisoned after watching his sons slaughtered, what is the fate of Judah's King Jehoiachin in 52:31-34? What does this teach you about God's sovereignty?**

Prayer Prompt: Read Psalm 25:4-11. Thank Him for his forgiveness, that He shows sinners the way and leads the humble. Praise Him for His redemptive plan and faithful love to His people.
