### **Week 27**

#### **Lamentations 1 - Ezekiel 15 | Psalm 28 - 34**

##### **Lamentations**

- 1. What is being mourned in Lamentations 1:14? Why is this type of grief important in genuine faith?**
- 2. Chapter 2 describes the desolation of Jerusalem but Chapter 3 renews hope. Read 3:22-33. What do these verses suggest about an appropriate response to the faithful discipline of God?**
- 3. Read 5:15-22. What do these verses remind us about sin? Do we take sin, and the effects of sin, seriously enough today? According to these verses, what should an appropriate response to sin include?**

##### **Ezekiel**

- 4. How is the appearance of the Lord's Glory described in 1:25-28?**
- 5. On what mission is Ezekiel sent in Chapter 2?**
- 6. What does God say He intends for His people in 11:14-21?**
- 7. What forms of judgement does God promise to send against Israel in 14:21-23?**

##### **Prayer Prompt**

**Deep and heartfelt grief over sin leads to greater appreciation of-, and rejoicing in-, the complete forgiveness we have in Christ. Read the verses below and spend time both searching your heart for unconfessed sin, and praising God for the totality of His forgiveness.**

**Psalm 30:11-12 You turned my lament into dancing; you removed sackcloth and clothed me with gladness so that I can sing to you and not be silent. Lord my God, I will praise you forever.**

**Psalm 32:1-2 How joyful is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered! How joyful is a person whom the Lord does not charge with iniquity and in whose spirit is no deceit!**
