- 4. What does Ezekiel 33:12-13 teach us about God's perspective on our righteousness? How is this perspective changed through The Gospel?**
- 5. In Ezekiel 34:25-31 God establishes a Covenant of peace with His people. What physical and spiritual needs would He provide as part of this Covenant?**
- 6. How does God plan to demonstrate His holiness through Israel in Ezekiel 36:24-30?**
- 7. What does Psalm 36:1-4 teach us about human wickedness?**
