6. Where did Abraham want the servant to go to find a bride for Isaac? Why did he choose the place he did?

7. What motive did the servant have in praying for a successful outcome in his search for a bride for Isaac?
8. Read verse 21. What do you learn about the servant from this verse and other verses where he is mentioned?
9. Read carefully the account of Rebecca. What character traits are seen by her actions? List them here:
10. What was the significance of verse 60? Do you think that the blessing spoken over her came true?

**READ Genesis 25:1-11**

11. After Sarah died and Isaac was settled with a bride, Abraham marries again. How many sons did Abraham have with Keturah?
12. Why did Abraham send them away? Where did he send them? From your previous knowledge of the Bible, do you recognize any of the countries named from among Keturah's sons?
13. Who made the funeral arrangements for Abraham? Talk about the things that come to your mind regarding this. Where was Abraham buried?
